Routine Bridge Inspection on U.S. Highway 67 Requires Temporary Lane Closures

PULASKI COUNTY (12-19) - A routine bridge inspection on U.S. Highway 67 requires temporary lane closures in North Little Rock, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; between **9:00 a.m.** and **3:00 p.m.** on **Thursday, December 21** crews will close half of the southbound off ramp from U.S. Highway 67 to Interstate 40 eastbound to inspect the structure. This work was originally scheduled for Tuesday, December 19, but was rescheduled due to weather.

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
