Routine Bridge Inspection on U.S. Highway 70 Requires Temporary Lane Closures

SALINE COUNTY (1-29) – Routine bridge inspection on U.S. Highway 70 requires temporary lane closures at the Interstate 30 / U.S. Highway 70 Interchange, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; between **9:00 a.m.** and **3:00 p.m.** on **Wednesday, January 31** crews will close half of the eastbound off ramp from U.S. Highway 70 to Interstate 30 westbound to inspect the structure.

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
