UPDATE **Construction Requires Lane Closures on** **Interstate 49 in Benton County**

BENTON COUNTY (8-20) – Asphalt work on Interstate 49 will require lane closures in Springdale and Lowell, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, lanes on I-49 will be closed overnight between Wagon Wheel Road (Exit 76) in Springdale and State Highway 264 (Exit 78) in Lowell. Due to weather conditions, these closures have been extended through **Saturday, August 25** and will occur during overnight hours from **8 p.m. to 6 a.m.**

The inside lanes of northbound and southbound I-49 will alternately be closed to allow the contractor to work on the asphalt pavement. Traffic will be controlled using traffic barrels and warning signs. Traffic will be restored daily by 6:00 a.m.
