Maintenance Work on State Highway 177 Bridge (Norfolk Dam) Requires Lane Closure

BAXTER COUNTY (1-25) – Maintenance work by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers on State Highway 177 (Norfolk Dam) requires continuing a lane closure, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

The southbound lane will **remain closed through 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 22** to allow the Corps of Engineers to repair a damaged concrete parapet wall. Originally this closure was scheduled to end on Thursday, January 25 but weather and unforeseen difficulties required extending the closure to complete repairs. Traffic will be controlled with flaggers, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
