Remediation Requires Temporary Lane Closure in Lonoke County

LONOKE COUNTY (1-31) – Remediation of a 40-foot section of median on Interstate 40 requires a temporary lane closure, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, on **Thursday, February 1**, remediation crews will close the inside westbound lane from **9:00 a.m. to 5:00 pm.** in Lonoke County at the Pulaski/Lonoke County line near mile marker 164. Crews will remove between two and eight inches of contaminated soil as a result of a diesel fuel spill from an incident that occurred on January 16, 2018.

Traffic will be controlled with traffic cones and warning signs. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
