Maintenance of Traffic Sensors to Require Lane Closures on Interstate 30 in Clark County

CLARK COUNTY (2-2) – Crews replacing sensors in a traffic box on Interstate 30 near Arkadelphia will require lane closures, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, **Tuesday, February 6th**, crews will close westbound lanes between Mile Markers 74 and 77 from **8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.** The inside lane will close first and once replacement is complete, crews will re-open the inside lane and close the outside lane.
