Maintenance Work on State Highway 312 Requires Temporary Closure in Mississippi County

MISSISSIPPI COUNTY (2-12) – Maintenance work on a State Highway 312 bridge requires a temporary closure of a section of State Highway 312, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

At **8:00 a.m.** on **Tuesday, February 13**, crews will close State Highway 312 from State Highway 18 (near Dell) to U.S. Highway 61 (south of Blytheville). Residential and farm access traffic will be allowed, but no traffic will be allowed to cross the bridge. This closure will allow crews to conduct maintenance on the bridge and will remain in place until work is complete, estimated to be one month.

Traffic will be controlled using traffic cones and warning signs. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
