Maintenance Work on U.S. Highways 70 & 270 Requires Temporary Lane Closures in Hot Springs

GARLAND COUNTY (2-9) – Maintenance work on U.S. Highways 70 & 270 (Dr Martin Luther King Jr Expy) requires temporary lane closures in Hot Springs, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; maintenance crews will conduct lane closures described below from **9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** to allow crews to refresh the paint on the roadways.

- On **Monday, February 12** there will be an alternating lane closure on U.S. Highway 270 eastbound between mile markers 0 and 4.
- On **Tuesday, February 13** there will be an alternating lane closure on U.S. Highway 70 eastbound between mile markers 0 and 3.
- On **Wednesday, February 14** there will be an alternating lane closure on U.S. Highway 70 westbound between mile markers 3 and 0.
- On **Thursday, February 15** there will be an alternating lane closure on U.S. Highway 270 westbound between mile markers 4 and 0.

Traffic will be controlled using traffic cones and warning signs. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
