Construction on U.S. Highway 67 Requires Temporary Lane Closure in Jacksonville

PULASKI COUNTY (3-20) – Construction on U.S. Highway 67 requires a temporary lane closure, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, on **Thursday, March 22nd**, from **9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.**, contractors will close the northbound outside lane of U.S. Highway 67 from the State Highway 440 interchange to north of the Main Street overpass to remove a precast concrete barrier wall.

Traffic will be controlled with flaggers, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
