Routine Maintenance Work on Interstate 30 Requires Temporary Lane Closure near Gurdon Rest Areas

CLARK COUNTY (4-9) – Routine maintenance work on Interstate 30 near the Gurdon Rest Areas requires a temporary lane closure, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; crews will close the outside westbound lane of I-30 between mile markers 58 and 59 daily between **8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.** starting on **Tuesday, April 10** and continuing through **Thursday, April 12**. This closure will allow crews to remove fallen trees and debris.

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic barrels. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
