### **Improvements on U.S. Highway 67 Requires Temporary Lane Closure in Jacksonville**

**PULASKI COUNTY (4-6)** - Testing of materials for the new construction on U.S. Highway 67 requires a temporary lane closure in Jacksonville, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; crews will close the outside northbound lane of U.S. Highway 67 between Redmond Road and Main Street from **9:00 p.m. on Monday, April 9 to 2:00 a.m.** the following morning.

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic barrels. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
