### **Maintenance on State Highway 124 Requires Temporary Closure near Sunnydale**

**WHITE COUNTY (4-13)** – Maintenance work on State Highway 124 requires a temporary closure approximately 2 miles west of Sunnydale, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; crews will close State Highway 124 approximately 2 miles west of Sunnydale starting at **8:00 a.m. on Monday, April 16**. This closure will allow crews to replace a culvert that runs under the highway. The work is expected to take a week to complete and the closure will remain in place until then. Please refer to attached map for recommended detour routes.

Traffic will be controlled with flaggers, signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones. 
# Highway 124 Detour
