Construction Requires Temporary Lane Closures on U.S. Highway 67 in Jacksonville

PULASKI COUNTY (4-13) – Construction on U.S. Highway 67 requires temporary lane closures, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, on **Tuesday, April 17th**, contractors will close both inside lanes of northbound and southbound traffic to place concrete pavement from the Redmond Road exit to the James St. exit.

- The **northbound** closure will occur **9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.**
- The **southbound** closure will occur **9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.**

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic barrels. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
