Routine Maintenance Requires Overnight Closure of Interstate 40 Exit in West Memphis

CRITTENDEN COUNTY (4-20) - Routine maintenance on an I-40 interchange ramp requires the overnight closure of Exit 280 in West Memphis, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, starting on **Sunday, April 22** at **11:00 p.m.** and continuing through **Tuesday, April 24** at **4:00 a.m.**, crews will conduct nightly closures of the westbound Martin Luther King Jr. Dr. off ramp (Exit 280) to complete the maintenance. Drivers are encouraged to use Exit 281 if they need to access Martin Luther King Jr. Dr.
