Improvements Require Temporary Lane Closures on Interstate 40 in Galloway

PULASKI COUNTY (4-20) – Improvements at the State Highway 391 interchange on Interstate 40 requires temporary lane closures in Galloway, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, on **Sunday, April 22** and **Wednesday April 25**, and **Thursday, April 26**, crews will close the westbound outside lane and exit ramp at Exit 161 from **9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.** to move a temporary barrier wall, pave the final asphalt surface, and move traffic to the newly constructed ramp. Westbound I-40 traffic intending to exit onto State Highway 391 will be detoured west on I-40 to I-440 west then to U.S. Highway 70 east and back to State Highway 391.

Weather permitting, on **Friday, April 27**, crews will close the eastbound lane and exit ramp at Exit 161 from **9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.** to move a barrier wall and place traffic on the newly constructed ramp. Eastbound I-40 traffic intending to exit onto State Highway 391 will be detoured to I-440 west then to U.S. Highway 70 east and back to State Highway 391.

Message boards will be in place to direct traffic to and along the detours. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
