### **Union Pacific Railroad Maintenance Requires Temporary Highway Closure Near the Louisiana State Line**


**LAFAYETTE COUNTY (4-24)** – Railroad track maintenance requires closure of State Highway 29 near the Louisiana State Line, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, on **Sunday, April 29** from **7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**, crews will close State Highway 29 near the Arkansas/Louisiana border for Union Pacific Railroad to perform track maintenance at a railroad crossing. Traffic will follow detour signs for the designated detour route through both Arkansas and Louisiana. Please see attached map.
