Construction Requires Nighttime Lane Closures on Interstate 49 in Benton County

BENTON COUNTY (4-30) – Crews hanging overhead signs for the future U.S. Highway 412 bypass in Springdale will require lane closures on Interstate 49 in Springdale and Lowell, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; the middle and outside lanes of southbound Interstate 49 will be closed between State Highway 264 (Exit 78) in Lowell and Wagon Wheel Road (Exit 76) in Springdale. These closures will occur **Tonight, Monday, April 30 at 11:00 p.m.** and continue through **2:00 a.m.**

Traffic will be controlled by construction barrels, signage, and police assistance.

This project (Job CA0907) is part of ARDOT's Connecting Arkansas Program. Approximately four miles of the new four-lane U.S. Highway 412 Northern Bypass has been constructed, which extends from Interstate 49 to State Highway 112.
