Improvements to U.S. Highway 67 Require Traffic Shift in Jacksonville

PULASKI COUNTY (5-11) – Construction work on U.S. Highway 67 requires lane closures in Jacksonville, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, beginning **Monday, May 14** and continuing thru **Friday, May 18**, southbound traffic will be temporarily reduced to one lane between the hours of **9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.** from Main St. to Redmond Rd to allow for removal of barrier wall and installation of final pavement markings. Once complete, all southbound lanes and the Main St. entrance ramp to southbound U.S. Highway 67 will be open to traffic.

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic barrels. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
