### **Routine Maintenance Requires Lane Closures in Garland County**

**GARLAND COUNTY (5-14)** – Routine maintenance requires several moving lane closures on state highways in Garland County, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting; the following highways will have moving lane closures from **9:00 a.m.** to **3:00 p.m.** on the inside lane while crews perform a cleaning operation:

- U.S. Highway 270 eastbound between mile markers 18 to 23 starting on **May 15**
- U.S. Highway 270 eastbound between mile markers 0 to 4 starting on **May 16**
- U.S. Highway 70 eastbound between mile markers 0 to 3 starting on **May 17**

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
