Routine Bridge Inspection on U.S. Highway 64 Requires Alternating Lane Closures

CRAWFORD & SEBASTIAN COUNTIES (5-14) – A routine inspection of the U.S. Highway 64 Arkansas River Bridge between Fort Smith and Van Buren requires a temporary lane closure, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, beginning **Tuesday, May 15** through **Thursday, May 17**, crews will perform alternating lane closures of the outside eastbound lane and outside westbound lane from **9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** each day.

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
