### **Repairs Require Temporary Overnight Lane Closure on Interstate 40 in Galloway**

**PULASKI COUNTY (5-30)** – Repairs to the temporary impact attenuator at the Valentine Road/State Highway 391 interchange require a temporary overnight lane closure on Interstate 40, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ArDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, on **Wednesday, May 30**, crews will close the I-40 outside westbound lane from the Valentine Road overpass to the State Highway 391 overpass from **9:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.** to repair the temporary impact attenuator (TIA).

A TIA, also known as a crash cushion, is a device intended to reduce the damage to structures, vehicles, and motorists resulting from a motor vehicle collision. They are designed to absorb the colliding vehicle's impact or redirect the vehicle away from a hazard, machinery, or workers.

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic barrels. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
