Additional Cameras in Place to Monitor Air Show Traffic

PULASKI COUNTY (10-25) – Additional cameras have been set-up to monitor traffic on U.S. Highway 67 throughout the Jacksonville area in anticipation of high volumes due to the Little Rock Air Force Base Air Show this weekend, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Eight portable cameras have been strategically located along the route and in addition to five cameras already in place. These 13 cameras will provide event organizers and law enforcement with constant situational awareness of traffic as it makes its way through the area.

The cameras are also publicly available on the ARDOT Traveler Information site www.IDriveArkansas.com. Cameras specifically being used to monitor air show traffic are depicted on the site with blue-colored icons. Motorists attending the air show are reminded to “Know Before You Go” and check travel conditions before heading out. Delays are expected.

Additionally, ARDOT is widening U.S. Highway 67 between Vandenberg Blvd. and State Highway 5 in Cabot. Although two lanes remain available in both directions, the work zone is being carefully watched in order to facilitate fast mitigation of vehicle accidents and breakdowns.

The Little Rock Air Force Base has asked the Department to help spread the word on how to access the air show from U.S. Highway 67. See attached for a map of those routes and note the restrictions for entry.


THUNDER OVER THE ROCK

DIRECTIONS:

Primary Public Entrance - Vandenberg or Marshall Gates

North from Little Rock

From Hwy. 67/167 North, take Exit 11. Turn left on T P White Dr. At the traffic light, turn left onto N. 1st St. At the following traffic light, continue straight onto Vandenberg Blvd. Proceed to either the Marshall or Vandenberg Entrance.

South from Cabot

From Hwy. 67/167 South, take Exit 11. At the traffic light, take a left on John Harden Dr. At the following traffic light, take a right on Vandenberg Blvd. Proceed to either the Marshall or Vandenberg Entrance.

Secondary Public Entrance - Arnold Gate

North from Sherwood

From AR-107 North, take a right onto Arnold Dr., followed by an immediate left onto the Arnold Gate access road.

South from Macon

From AR-107 South, take a left onto Arnold Dr., followed by an immediate left onto the Arnold Gate access road.

*DISCLAIMERS: **The Arnold Gate Route may have rough terrain.**
The BASE shuttle is only available to DoD ID card holders and their ESCORTED guests.
Flightline Club Members - VIP parking instructions will be provided prior to the event.

The following list of items are PROHIBITED on Little Rock Air Force Base:

**** Random vehicle inspections are authorized****

- **WEAPONS** (regardless of permit) INCLUDING FIREARMS, KNIVES (including pocket knives and multi-tools), REPLICA OR TOY WEAPONS, PEPPER SPRAY OR STUN GUNS.
- Alcoholic Beverages, unless purchased from approved vendors on site
- Remote control devices that operate on land or in air (cars, planes, drones etc.)
- Ice chests or coolers
- Pets (other than service animals)
- Illegal drugs and/or paraphernalia
- Flammable liquids
- Glass containers
- Bicycles, roller skates, skate boards, Heelys, scooters, or segway-style human transporters (strollers are acceptable if there is a child inside)
- Fireworks
- Laser Pointers
- Tents, portable awnings, cabanas, umbrellas or other shelter-type equipment
- Bags larger than a child's school backpack
- Outside food and beverages - ABSOLUTELY NO TAILGATING
- Explosives of ANY kind
- Medical Marijuana (regardless of prescription)
