### **Bridge Maintenance Requires Alternating Lane Closures over Mississippi River**

**CRITTENDEN COUNTY (11-30)** – Bridge deck maintenance requires alternating lane closures of the Interstate 55 Bridge over the Mississippi River between West Memphis and Memphis, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ArDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, crews will close the outside southbound lane of the I-55 Bridge over the Mississippi River **Monday, December 3 through Thursday, December 6** daily from **9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

Crews will place alternating lane closures on the northbound lanes of the I-55 Bridge over the Mississippi River **Monday through Thursday** daily from **7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.** starting on Monday, **December 10** and continuing for four weeks or until work is completed.

Traffic will be controlled with signage and traffic cones or barrels. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
