Routine Bridge Inspection Requires Temporary Lane Closures on Interstate 40 Mississippi River Bridge

CRITTENDEN COUNTY (8-27) – A routine bridge inspection requires temporary lane closures on the I-40 Mississippi River Bridge, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, **Wednesday, September 4** and **Thursday September 5** the outside westbound lane will be closed from **7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** Additionally an outside lane closure, starting on the westbound and moving to the eastbound side, will be required **Monday, September 9** through **Thursday, September 12**. A westbound lane closure may be in place between 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. or an eastbound lane closure may be in place from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Traffic will be controlled by signage and traffic barrels. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
