Maintenance Work on Interstate 430 Requires Overnight Lane Closures in Little Rock

PULASKI COUNTY (9-6) – Maintenance work on the I-430 overpasses for Colonel Glenn Road and 36th Street requires overnight lane closures on I-430 in Little Rock, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, crews will close the two inside northbound lanes of I-430 between Colonel Glenn Rd. (Exit 4) and 36th St. between **7:00 p.m.** and **5:00 a.m.** nightly starting on **Sunday night, September 8** through **Thursday morning, September 12.**

Traffic will be controlled by signage and traffic cones. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
