Maintenance Work on State Highway 177 (Norfork Dam) Requires Long-term Lane Closure

BAXTER COUNTY (10-14) – Maintenance work by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers on State Highway 177 (Norfork Dam) requires a long-term lane closure, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

A single lane will be closed at **9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 15 2019** and will remain closed ***24 hours a day, seven days a week*** until **Thursday, October 15 2020**. Work will begin in the northbound lane with a scheduled switch to the southbound lane in May 2020. Traffic will be controlled by traffic barrels and signage. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
