## Department Seeking Public Input about Section 106 Programmatic Agreement

**Statewide (12-01)** – The Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT), through the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), Arkansas Division Office, initiated consultation regarding a Section 106 Programmatic Agreement (Agreement) for the Federal-aid Highway Program in the State of Arkansas in order to comply with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and its implementing regulations, 36 CFR Part 800 – Protection of Historic Properties. ARDOT invited federal agencies, Indian tribes, state agencies and organizations, city and county organizations, and Certified Local Governments to provide initial comments on the draft Agreement.

FHWA and ARDOT's have developed this Agreement to address the nature of the program and its likely effects on historic properties. ARDOT would like to invite the public to review and comment on the Agreement and notify us of any concerns that you may have regarding this Agreement within a 30-day period.

The public is invited to view the existing Agreement and provide written comments. Written comments can be sent through the online comment forms to ARDOT staff at the link below. The website will be available for comments until **4:30 p.m. on Friday, January 6, 2021.**
