Improvements to Interstate 40 in North Little Rock Will Require Temporary Lane Closure

PULASKI COUNTY (7-21) – Improvements to Interstate 40 in North Little Rock will require a temporary lane closure, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, crews will put in place a closure for the outside westbound lane of I-40 between Protho Junction (Exit 157) and Springhill Drive (Exit 156) from **10:00 p.m. on the night of Wednesday, July 22 to 5:00 a.m. the following morning.** This closure will allow crews to replace signage.
