UPDATE DUE TO WEATHER IMPACTS!

Improvements to Interstate 430 Arkansas River Bridge Need Overnight Lane Closures

PULASKI COUNTY (12-03) – Improvements to the Interstate 430 Arkansas River Bridge and surrounding highway need overnight lane closures, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, crews will close a single outside lane of northbound I-430 from Rodney Parham Road to the Maumelle Interchange on **Thursday, December 3 and Friday, December 4 from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. the following morning.**

The purpose of this project is to reconstruct the existing shoulders, construct bridge modifications and install intelligent transportation system equipment on I-430 between Highways 10 and 100. The contract was awarded to Concrete Strategies LLC on June 24, 2020, for \$31,722,871.06 and is estimated to be completed in late 2022.
