Pavement Work on Interstate 30 Requires Double-Lane Weekend Closure in Little Rock

PULASKI COUNTY (12-10) – Work on Interstate 30 in Little Rock will require a westbound I-30 double-lane closure, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, crews will close the left two lanes between the Arkansas River and south of the I-630 interchange for paint removal and restriping. This work will require a weekend closure, beginning **Friday**, **December 18 at 10:00 p.m.** and continuing through **Monday**, **December 21 at 5:00 a.m.**

Traffic will be controlled with construction barrels and signage. The public is advised to be cautious when traveling in the work zone and **watch for slower traffic speeds**.
