Traffic Pattern Changes along Interstate 30 Corridor in Little Rock

PULASKI COUNTY (12-31) – Construction in the Interstate 30 work zone in Little Rock will require changes to travel patterns in early January, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, the following travel impacts will begin the week of **January 4**. <u>See attached</u> <u>map NR 20-387-A</u> for locations.


- Mon., Jan. 4 | Closed through summer 2021 | Mahlon Martin St. | Street closed between President Clinton Ave. and 3rd St., including connection with 2nd St. See attached map NR 20-387-B for detour route.
- Mon., Jan. 4 | Permanent closure | 2nd St. On-Ramp to Eastbound I-30 | Entrance ramp closed at 2nd St. and Mahlon Martin St. Traffic to detour south to 6th St. on-ramp.
- Mon., Jan. 4 Sat., Jan. 23 | Temporary closure | 3rd St. | Street closed at intersection with Mahlon Martin St. See attached map NR 20-387-B for detour route.

Traffic will be controlled by signage, construction barrels, and barriers. The public is advised to be cautious when traveling in the work zone and **watch for slower traffic speeds**.
