Maintenance to Signage Requires Temporary Overnight Lane Closure on Interstate 40

PULASKI COUNTY (1-13) – Maintenance of overhead signage in North Little Rock requires a temporary overnight lane closure on Interstate 40, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, crews will close the eastbound outside lane of I-40 at Mile Marker 155 **Wednesday, January 15** from **11:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m.** to repair overhead signs.

Traffic will be controlled by traffic cones and signage. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
