Routine Bridge Inspection Requires Temporary Lane Closure in Little Rock

PULASKI COUNTY (1-23) – A routine bridge inspection on the Interstate 440 Bridge over the Arkansas River requires a temporary lane closure, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, crews will close the outside lane of Interstate 440 **Monday, January 27 and Thursday, January 30** from **9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.** The inspection will begin with the **westbound lanes and move to the eastbound lanes.**

Traffic will be controlled by traffic barrels and signage. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
