### **Routine Bridge Inspection Requires Temporary Lane Closure in Little Rock**

**PULASKI COUNTY (1-21)** – A routine bridge inspection on the Interstate 440 Bridge over the Arkansas River requires a temporary lane closure, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, crews will close the outside lane of Interstate 440 **Wednesday, January 22** and **Thursday, January 23** from **9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.** The inspection will begin with the eastbound lanes and move to the westbound lanes.

Traffic will be controlled by traffic barrels and signage. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
