Repairs in Jacksonville Require Temporary Alternating Lane Closures on U.S. 67

PULASKI COUNTY (6-9) – Repairs to the James Street overpass over U.S. Highway 67 in Jacksonville requires alternating lane closures, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Weather permitting, crews will conduct alternating lane closures in the southbound lane **weekdays** starting on **Tuesday, June 9** and continuing through **Tuesday, June 16** between **9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.** each day.

Traffic will be controlled by traffic cones and signage. Drivers should exercise caution when approaching and traveling through all highway work zones.
