POSTPONED! WEATHER DELAYS!

Interstate 430 River Bridge Closure Postponed Again Due to Weather

PULASKI COUNTY (2-23) – The Interstate 430 Bridge Closure is delayed once again due to unfavorable weather predicted for the upcoming weekend, according to Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) officials.

Plans are being made to reschedule the bridge closure for a weekend with more favorable weather conditions; specific dates have not been determined at this time but will be announced as soon as possible.

When weather permits, these operations will allow crews to erect structural beams and install safety platforms. This single weekend closure will minimize the number of nightly lane closures required, thereby reducing the risk and exposure to the motorist as well as the construction personnel.
