Department Seeking Public Input about Potential Improvements to Connect Northern Pulaski County to Interstate 40 and Highway 67/167

PULASKI COUNTY (3-1) - The Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) and Metroplan, in cooperation with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and local governments, are conducting a study of potential improvements to connect points within northern Pulaski County and to connect northern Pulaski County to Interstate 40 and Highway 67/167.
