ARBENEFITS: EXTENSION OF CORONAVIRUS BENEFITS

The Employee Benefits Division wants to ensure that treatment and prevention care remain accessible to all members throughout the duration of the COVID-19 pandemic. In response to this commitment, we feel it is helpful to extend the following benefits through January 21, 2021.

1. NO-COST OR PRIOR AUTHORIZATION FOR IN-NETWORK CORONAVIRUS TESTING:

If your provider determines that testing is necessary, members and dependents can get tested without a co-pay, co-insurance or deductible. Additionally, no prior authorization paperwork will be required as along as all CDC guidelines are met.

2. COVERAGE FOR TELEMEDICINE AT NO MEMBER COST SHARE:

Telemedicine appointments will be covered with no deductible, co-insurance or co-pay.

It is important to remember that to utilize the benefits listed above, you must use an in-network provider. All necessary COVID-19 related testing will be eligible for coverage.

ARDOT RECEIVES GOVERNOR'S QUALITY AWARD

The Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) was one of fourteen organizations from across the state to be recognized with an Arkansas Governor's Quality Award during an Annual Awards Celebration held October 6 in Little Rock.

Governor Asa Hutchinson presented ARDOT with a Commitment Award. Commitment Award recipients have earned the second of four

award levels and are moving toward the fourth and highest level in the state—the Governor's Quality Award for Performance Excellence.

The goal of the program is to encourage Arkansas organizations to engage in continuous quality improvement, which leads to performance excellence. The award process drives organizations toward quality principles. Organizations self-assess and carefully review the award-level requirements before deciding at which level to apply. Each level increases the requirements of the applicant to describe systematic processes and results. In addition to the award recognition, the greatest value for program participants is the in-depth evaluation and written feedback report citing strengths and areas for improvement.

"ARDOT's goal is to always perform at a high level as we work towards our goal of providing the best highway system possible," stated ARDOT Director Lorie Tudor.

"This program gives us the opportunity to measure our progress and gain valuable advice as we work towards the future."

Created as a not-for-profit organization, the Governor's Quality Award program is dedicated to assist in building a strong infrastructure for Arkansas businesses. The award process aligns with the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality award and uses the Baldrige Excellence Framework.

The Governor's Quality Award program is coordinated by the Arkansas Institute for Performance Excellence, a nonprofit organization affiliated with the Arkansas State Chamber of Commerce. ◆


