Public To Participate in Commission Meetings

The Arkansas State Highway Commission has scheduled a series of public involvement sessions across the state to discuss the results of its 2003 Arkansas State Highway Needs Study, according to Highway Commission Chairman J.W. "Buddy" Benafield. The purpose of the meetings is to present the study results and solicit public involvement into the highway planning process.

"The study addresses the costs associated with development of Arkansas' highway transportation needs over the next ten years, as well as the expected funding over that time period," said Benafield. "The bottom line is that we have identified \$16 billion in needs with anticipated funding of only \$4 billion."

Each meeting will consist of a brief presentation on the current condition and future needs on the State Highway System, followed by comments from the audience. Written comments will also be accepted.

"It is important that the general public understands the situation," said Dan Flowers, Director of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD). "Current funding for highway improvements is not keeping pace with our growing needs. We need the public's input as we plan for future highway improvements."

A total of ten meetings are scheduled across the state, beginning January 27 in Jonesboro. Other

locations include Helena, Springdale, Fort Smith, Batesville, Little Rock, El Dorado, Pine Bluff, Russellville and Texarkana.

"The citizens of Arkansas are interested in good highways and many of them have specific projects they want to see completed," Benafield added. "The Commission appreciates that interest and wants to hear it first-hand through this series of meetings."

I-30 Lane Closure And Traffic Shift Is Underway Between Geyer Springs And I-430

The evening of Friday, January 30th marked the beginning of new travels for AHTD Central employees. Work crews for Gilbert Central began shifting Interstate 30 traffic to new concrete lanes between Geyer Springs Road and I-430, including the new bridge structure over Baseline Road. Westbound travel lanes were shifted first, followed by eastbound lanes a few days later. With the transition complete, permanent off ramps at McDaniel Drive and Baseline Road are restored. Westbound on-ramps to I-30 at Geyer Springs and University Avenue will no longer require a stop sign before entering the Interstate since acceleration lanes are in place on the new concrete.

For several days during the eastbound lane shift to the new concrete roadway, Exit 130 prior to Mablevale Pike and Baseline Road must be used for access to the eastbound frontage road and businesses between I-430 and Geyer Springs Road. A new, temporary exit ramp for University Avenue will be in place throughout the remainder of the project until mid-2005 while original exit ramps #131 to Chicot Road and #132 to University Avenue will be closed during this time. During the adjustment period for traveling on newly shifted I-30 lanes, motorists are encouraged to stay alert, follow all speed limits and allow extra time to travel through the construction zone to reach their destinations.






