United Way Recognizes AHTD

The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department has received recognition from the United Way for its 2005 United Way campaign.

The Department received a Crest Award at a United Way Campaign Celebration held in Little Rock on March 16th. The award recognizes a company or agency for its dedication and commitment to the campaign. To earn a Crest award, an agency must meet two of four criteria: a 10% increase in employee giving, \$100 or more per capita per employee, one

or more Pillar Society donors, or 50% or more participation.

In addition to the Crest Award, AHTD Personnel Specialist Carla Edwards was presented with the Outstanding Coordinator of the Year award for the AHTD's category. Edwards has coordinated AHTD's United Way campaign for the past five years.

AHTD employees across the state raised a total of \$25,532.23 for the 2005 United Way campaign.



Two from Computer Services Tackle Little Rock Marathon

Charlie Frame and Ron Mitchell, of AHTD's Computer Services Division, had never run in a race quite so long before. On March 5th, they lined up to compete in their very first marathon.

Frame, age 57, and Mitchell, age 42, joined 6,000 other runners early that morning to run in the Little Rock Marathon.

Running a marathon can be a grueling task, especially for someone who has never run one before. It is approximately 26 miles and takes multiple hours to complete.

For Charlie and Ron, this was a new experience.

"I run two or three 5K races per month," stated Frame. 5K races are a little over three miles in length.

As for Ron, "I run mostly 5K races for fun but did complete the Little Rock Half Marathon last year and thought I would try the marathon this year." Running in a marathon isn't something you jump right into. To properly train for a race takes months.

"I did a four-month training program which consisted of two short runs and one long run per week," Mitchell stated. "I added mileage to the long run until I was able to run about 20 miles without stopping."

Frame also put in some extra training. "I run about 30 miles per week when not training for a marathon, but increased to about 35 miles per week at a slower pace two months before the marathon. I learned from this race to start earlier than two months. Next time I will start at 21 weeks prior to the race and increase my mileage no more than ten percent each time. I plan on running the marathon again next year to improve my time."

Training paid off for both men. Frame finished the marathon in 5 hours and 36 minutes. Mitchell crossed the finish line after 4 hours and 9 minutes.





Frame and Mitchell both gave credit to their families for their success.

"My supporters were my wife, son and grandson. I could not have made it without the help of my son, Brian, who helped me train," commented Frame.

For Mitchell, his wife Stacy was a big supporter. "She helped me train and cheerfully provided support on race day," Mitchell added.

Asked if he would do it again next year Mitchell responded, "Maybe, but the 5K races are more fun and hurt less!"

The increase in funding is additional contributions paid by the State of Arkansas and was not enough to offset the increase in medical and pharmacy expenses.


