Favorite part of the job: Working with a very good crew of women and men at Pope County.

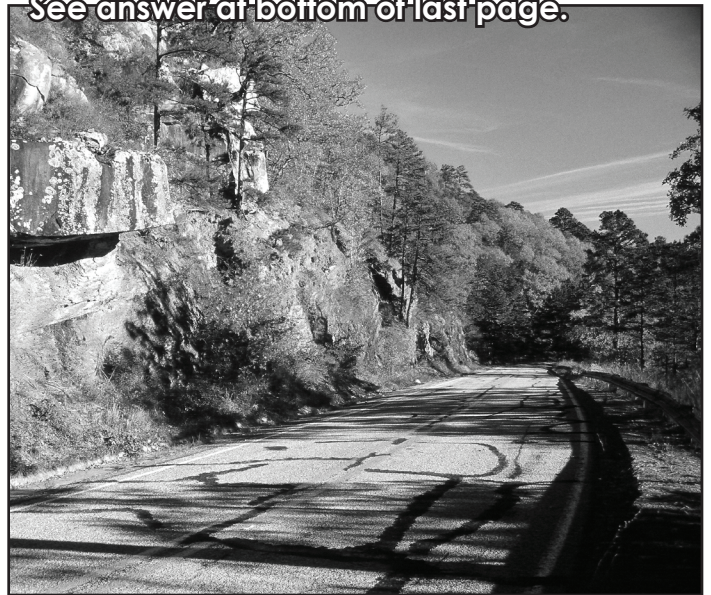

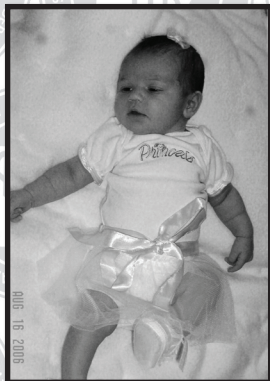
Veteran's Day Holiday

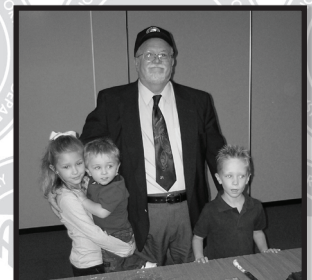

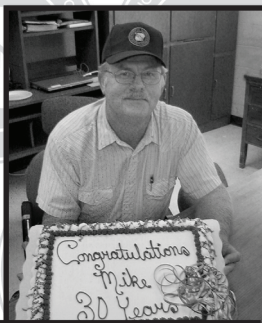

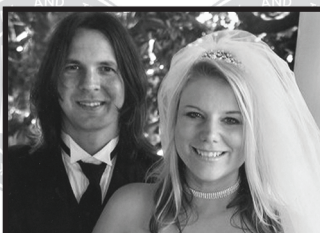
