Flooded Highways

The heavy rainstorms that have been hitting our state over the past several months have taken their toll on Arkansas' highway system. The higher than normal rain amounts began in March and not only left high water standing on the roadways, but caused damage to many as well.

Over the past two months, sections of approximately 100 highways have been closed at some point in time due to standing water on the roadways. Even as late as May 1st, five highways were still closed due to high water.


