

NOTICE OF LOCATION PUBLIC HEARING

The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD), in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), will conduct an open forum Location Public Hearing to discuss the proposed improvements to Highway 7 in Dover. The Location Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, December 6, 2011, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., at the Dover Middle School Fine Arts Building (Cafeteria), located at 170 College Street in Dover.

The open forum format allows concerned citizens the opportunity to attend the hearing anytime between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Representatives of AHTD will be present to answer questions concerning the proposed project. Information on the proposed location, right of way appraisal and acquisition procedures, and the environmental documentation will be available at the hearing.
