The Mississippi Department of Transportation and the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department are finalizing a study to determine the feasibility of building an enhanced highway corridor that would connect I-40 in Brinkley or Forrest City, Arkansas to I-55 in Batesville, Mississippi.
