

NOTICE OF DESIGN PUBLIC HEARING

Job No. 050251 Hwy. 16 – Hwy. 67 White County

The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD), in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), will conduct an open forum Design Public Hearing to discuss the proposed design of a new highway from Highway 16 to Highway 67. The hearing will be held on Tuesday, September 24, 2013, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., at the College Church of Christ in the Family Room, located at 712 East Race Avenue in Searcy.

The open forum format allows concerned citizens the opportunity to meet with representatives of AHTD, view the proposed design and ask questions concerning the proposed project. Information on the proposed right of way appraisal and acquisition procedures, as well as the environmental documentation, will be available at the hearing.

The proposed project will connect Highway 16 to Highway 67. The purpose of the proposed project is to improve east-west connectivity and to provide an additional avenue of travel north of the Searcy metro area. This project is part of a larger project to construct a new connector route that would link Highways 36, 16 and 67, in and around the City of Searcy.

A copy of the proposed design plans and the environmental assessment are available for public inspection at the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department's Resident Engineers Office #55, 2015 East Line Road in Searcy or by contacting the Environmental Division at (501) 569-2281.
