

NOTICE OF DESIGN PUBLIC HEARING

The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD), in conjunction with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), will conduct an open forum Design Public Hearing to discuss the proposed design of the Highway 70 Arkansas River Bridge (Broadway Bridge). The hearing will be held on Thursday, March 28, 2013, from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., at the Arkansas Transit Association (Training Room), 620 West Broadway Street, North Little Rock, Arkansas.

The open forum format allows concerned citizens the opportunity to attend the hearing anytime between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Representatives of AHTD and Garver Engineering will be present to answer questions concerning the proposed design.
