These updates include the continued refinement of both the 8-lane General Purpose and 6-Lane with Collector/Distributor Lanes (previously called the PEL Recommendation 10-lane with Downtown C/D) alternatives, traffic modeling of both alternatives, interchange options for access to downtown Little Rock, and the initiation of the environmental evaluation process for both corridor alternatives.
