PURPOSE OF STUDY

- Determine the need for highway safety and mobility improvements
- Identify feasible alternatives for addressing needs
- Make recommendations for short-, interim- and long-range improvements
- Engage with stakeholders throughout the study process

WORK PERFORMED TO DATE

- Conducted initial public involvement meetings (July 2018)
- Compiled and reviewed public comments
- Analyzed historic traffic trends and developed traffic forecasts
- Analyzed travel speed data
- Analyzed crash records
- Documented pavement and bridge conditions
- Reviewed previous studies
- Identified areas of need and potential improvements

PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING

- Present preliminary findings and receive stakeholder feedback
- Discuss priorities for future work

NEXT STEPS

- Study team will review stakeholder input and finalize study documents for presentation to the ARDOT Administration and Arkansas State Highway Commission.
- This study will be used as a guide for possible future improvements. At this time, no funds have been identified for those improvements except for those projects that are already included in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program.
